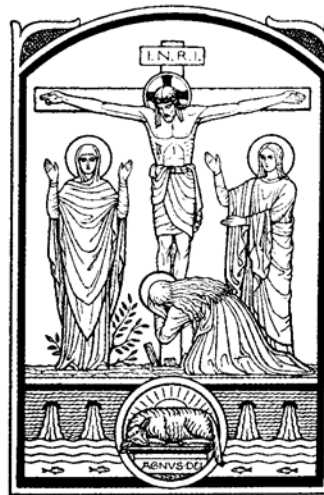
FRIDAYS DURING LENT
